It is the Desire of his Excellency and the Council that during their remaining Court you make particular Enquiry into the Behaviour of the Roman Catholic in your County since your Report in Answer to a former Letter to this Office his Excellency and their Honour's desire likewise that you will before the End of the next year make a Report to them concerning the conduct of those People since your former Report and if you have behaved otherwise than became dutiful and loyal Subjects they desire to know what Notice the Court has taken thereof, and what Punishment has been inflicted on the offenders.
