Proprietary his Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid relative to his Knowledge of the Surveyor of
Kent County on Delaware his making Surveys within the Reputed Limits of this Province and within
Limits Respected by the Inhabitants thereof Deponeth and saith that in the Month of September in the
Year he been hundred and fifty eight William Hillen Surveyor of Kent County aforesaid by virtue of
Warrant for that Purpose did Survey and lay out for John Deharty and Allen & Thomas both Inhabitants
of this County a Tract or Parcel of Land containing two hundred Acres or thereabouts running about three
Quarters of a Mile within the Inhabitants of this Province and within the reputed Limits thereof And
this Deponent saith that the aforesaid John Deharty did get of the said Land about two thousand
Slaves and that the aforesaid Allen & Thomas did get about three thousand Slaves of the aforesaid Land

being sworn on the holy Evangelis of Almighty God before the Subscriber one of the Right Honourable the
Lord Proprietary his Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid relative to his Knowledge of the Surveyor
of Kent County on Delaware his making Surveys within the Inhabitants of this Province or the reputed
Limits and Bounds thereof Deponeth and saith that about seven years past he this Deponent was
present when William Hillen Surveyor of Kent County aforesaid surveyed & laid out for Dominick Bright
and Moses Nichols a Tract or Parcel of Land Quantity about two hundred Acres or thereabouts the aforesaid
Tract of Land running half a Mile within Lands held in Maryland and this Deponent saith that there
has been about ten or twelve thousand Slaves got of the aforesaid Land by certain Robert Newens
