A Proclamation.

Whereas the present General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Monday the seventh day of October next. And Whereas some Business for the General Utility of the Province requires their Attendance before that time; I have thought fit with the Advice of his Lordships Council of State to Order that this General Assembly meet and be held at the City of Annapolis on Monday the 23rd day of this instant September and to the Intent that all Persons concerned may have due Notice thereof, do Strictly charge and require the several Sheriffs of this Province to make this my Proclamation publick in their respective Counties in the usual manner as they will answer the contrary at their peril. Given at Annapolis this 12th day of September in the fifteenth Year of his Lordships Dominion Anno Domini 1765
