I return you thankg, for the Letter you were pleased to write the 22. Instant to Oder me
of your having received on Board his Majesty's Ship, Surveine, the Stamp Paper, which had been
brought in the Royal Charter for this Province. As we have no place of security where the Paper
now or late to hand, could be lodged. I should be afraid to have it brought on Shore till I can commu-
nicate to the Govr. which is to meet here next Thursday, the contents of your Letter and receive
the advice on the occasion last; otherwise, the Paper should be destroyed by the Captain. In the
mean time, I must desire the favour of you to keep the Paper on Board the Surveine, until you should
have an opportunity of putting it on Board some other of his Majesty's Ships bound to this Province.
