Charles County 16. August 1766.

The Clerk of this Court presented to us a Letter from the Clerk of the Council, during the Examination of the Evidence that appeared against Negro George Justin and Negro Jonathan, who were Convicted of Felony at June Court last. It has been the uniform Practice of this Court, when any matter appears favourable to the Criminals, to recommend them to your Excellency's Clemency, and we sincerely wish it was in our Power to say any thing in favour of these unhappy People, they have broke Goal and the Sheriff hath offered a Reward for apprehending of them.

We are very that there did not appear one favourable circumstance in the course of his Trial to induce us to recommend him to your Excellency for Mercy.
