Charles County 16. August 1766.

The Clerk of this Court presented to us a Letter from the Clerks of the Council, desiring the Circumstances of the Evidence that appeared against Negro George Austin and Negro Jonathan, who were Convicted of Felony at this Court last. It has been the uniform Practice of this Court, when any matter appeared favourable to the Criminals, to recommend them to your Excellency's Clemency, and we sincerely wish it was in our Power to say any thing in favour of these unhappy People, they have broke Goal and the Sheriff hath offered a Reward for apprehending of them

We the Justices of the Western Shore Assizes do humbly represent to your Excellency That Patrick Mackenzy of Baltimore County Labourer at a Session of Assize held for the said County on the second day of September instant has been indicted tried and convicted of Feloniously Stealing a Gelding the Property of one John Cuyten and sentence of Death has been pronounced against him

We are sorry that there did not appear one favourable Circumstance in the Course of his Trial to induce us to recommend him to your Excellency for Mercy
