

It being represented to this Board that Mr. John Griffith, who was appointed by the Honorable Congress Director of the Hospital at Baltimore Town, declines to act, and that the Continental Troops, as well some of those raised in Virginia, as some of those raised in this State, now under Inoculation, there are not furnished with such Food, as is proper and necessary in their Circumstances, Mr. James Calhoun is requested to employ a proper Person to purchase and furnish for the use of that Hospital, Rice, Indian Meal, Potatoes, and such other Food, as may be necessary for the sick, and render an Account thereof to this Board.

James John Skinner appointed as third Lieutenant in the Artillery Service of this State.
