

Ordered, That the western Shore Treasury pay to
Deamus O'Regan four Pounds for ^{cost} of his ^{services}.

That Captain Patterson Master of the Schooner
Dolphin proceed to Baltimore with the sick of the Ship Defense.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to
Captain Locke for the use of the sick five Blankets, five hundred
weight of Cannon Powder, three hundred Gunflints of fifty weight
of Musquet Ball for the Ship Defense.

That the western Shore Treasury pay to Leonard
Hitch three Pounds, seven shillings and six Pence for ^{cost} of his ^{services}.

Mr. John Locke offers himself to qualify as a
Member of this Board. Wherefore the Honorable the General Assembly
is requested to certify this Board, whether Mr. Locke hath, or hath not,
refused to act, there being yet only one person chosen by the Council as member
and he in the Room of Charles Canoth Louis Esquire, whose refusal to
act is entered on the Proceedings of the Senate.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores
deliver to Captain Daich three hundred and fifty weight of Gun Powder
twenty four Cuthages, half of a Beam of Cartridge Paper, and Sheet Lead
sufficient for Aprons for Cannon. That the western Shore Treasury pay
to Captain Alexander Turnwall for the use of Jesse Hothingsworth one
thousand five hundred Pounds, to be accounted for.

It being represented that many persons
duly enlisted in the service of this State have not joined any
Regiment, or Corps, all such are ordered immediately to repair to
Annapolis, and Authority is hereby given to any Officer in the
service of the United States, or of this State, to take the Command
of any such enlisted persons, or if necessary, to arrest any of them,
the Officer so taking the Command of, or arresting any of them bringing
them before the Governor Council.
