Elihu Hall Junior appointed Ensign
in the first Company of the first Regiment.

Nathaniel Burgess appointed Ensign
of the eighth Company in the first Regiment.

Ordered, That the western Shore
Treasure pay to Ebenezer Handy twenty five Shillings,
for 40 Blankets.

That the said Treasure pay
to Lieut^t. Edward Duvall four Pounds, seven Shillings for
Blankets for four Soldiers, in Captain Neale's Company.

That the said Treasure pay
to David Hunter fifteen Pounds, five Shillings, for
Blankets of Sect.

That the said Treasure pay
to Capt. Arch^d. Anderson thirty five Shillings, for
Blankets of Certificate.
