

Ordered That the Comptroller of the Treasury to
Contract the Price, for the use of the second Regiment, in
making Cotton Surplices, to make Blankets, allowing
five yards to each Blanket wanting.

That the Western Shore Treasury pay to Edward
Thier twenty shillings for a Pair of Breeches found himself
last Campaign. That the said Treasury pay to Captain John
Dunbar five Pounds, ten shillings for Blankets of Am^t of
Ac^t.

That the said Treasury pay to Alexander
Gordon ten Pounds, two shillings, and five Pence, for Am^t of
Ac^t.

Ac^t.

That the said Treasury pay to Christopher
Eubank seventy one Pounds, five shillings, for Stockings
& Certificate of Capt. Poind's Regiment.

That the said Treasury pay to John
Smith nine Pounds, eight shillings and two Pence, for
Am^t of Ac^t.
