men.

pay to James Taylor eight pounds and nine pence, for
Acct. of Acct.

That the said Treasury pay to Major
Daniel Jenifer Adams for the use of the seventh Regt.
three thousand Dollars, being Part of the sum required
by Colonel Gunby.

May 1st 1777.

George Wolfe appointed first Lieut.
of the Ship Defiance, he having served from the eighteenth
Day of March last.

John Rogers appointed second Lieut.
of the Ship Defiance, he having served from the seventh Day
of March last.

Samuel Walker appointed Master
of the Ship Defiance, he having served from the twenty second
