

Ordered That Mr. Jean LaMarche on Friday
the tenth Instant deliver out the three hundred Bushels of
County made Salt lately bought in by Mr. Mathew to
such of the Inhabitants of this State, who will apply for
the same in quantities not exceeding one Bushel to a
Family, and at the Rate of three Dollars per Bushel.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to
Major Dant J. Adams twenty Suits of Cloaths for the use of
the seventh Regiment. That the western Shore Treasurer pay
to Benedict Snipe for the use of Van Bibber and Crockett
by order of Jenifer and Hood two thousand pounds, or
Accts.

That Doctor Robert Welch attend
the Governor and Council with Lieutenant Smith, and also
bring with him the Boy, whom he brought from the Jersey,
and Lieutenant Smith is hereby empowered to enforce the
Execution of this order.

That the western Shore Treasurer pay
to William Gohdsmith one hundred pounds, to be accounted
for.

The Governor and Council agree with
Thomas Hyde for the Rent of his Tanyard, Uttonfite, and
Stamps thereto belonging at the Rate of fifty pounds per Annum,
and the sum of one hundred pounds for the Bark now at the
said Tan-yard.

Ordered, That the western Shore Treasurer
pay to George Gordon four pounds for a Gun.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt.
John Gibbons one hundred pounds, five shillings and two pence
for Bark Accts.
