

Ordered That Mr. Jean be allowed on Friday
the tenth instant deliver out the three hundred Bushels of
Country made Salt lately brought in by Mr. Wallace to
such of the inhabitants of this State, who will pay for
the same in quantities not exceeding one Bushel to each
Family, and at the Rate of two Dollars per Bushel.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to
Major Genl. J. Adams twenty Drums of Cloathes for the use of
the Seventh Regiment. That the western Store Treasuror pay
to Benedict Slope for the use of Van Bibbe and Cockett,
by order of Leaife and Hood two thousand pounds, on
acc't.

That Doctor Robert Welsh attend
the Governor and Council with Lieutenant Smith, and also
bring with him the Boy, whom he brought from the Jersey,
and Lieutenant Smith is hereby empowered to enforce the
Execution of this order.

That the western Store Treasuror pay
to William Geddes one hundred pounds, to be accounted
for.

The Governor and Council agree with
Thomas Hyde for the Rent of his Tanyard, Utensils, and
Horse thate belonging at the Rate of fifty pounds per annum,
and the sum of one hundred pounds for the Bark now at the
said Tan-yard.

Ordered, That the western Store Treasuror
pay to George Gordon four pounds for a Gun.

That the said Treasuror pay to Capt. John Gibbons one hundred pounds, five shillings and ten pence
for Bal's Acc't.
