It is the Opinion of this Board that James Mad formerly a Drummer in Capt. Hindman's Company now in the fifth Regiment properly belongs to the second Regiment, and that two persons mentioned in William Frazer's Deposition to have been enlisted by Pitts and Worthington now retained as Soldiers in the second Regiment belong properly to the fifth Regiment, and that all the said Persons ought respectively to be returned to their own Regiments.

Ordered, That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Sin Lee fifty six Pounds, for forty Days Attendance in Council.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Sin thirty five pounds, fifteen shillings for twenty six Days Attendance in Council.
