Ordered, That the Western Shore
Treasury pay to Governor Johnson twelve hundred Dollars
to be delivered to Benjamin Johnson for paying for the
Carriage of Powder to Fred^d Town, and the work to be
delivered over to the Person, or Persons having the Care of
the Prisoners lately sent to Magazins Town, for their
Subsistence.

That the said Treasury pay to Captain
John Darch two hundred and fifty nine pounds, nineteen
shillings and five pence for Am^t of acct.

shillings each.
