On considering the Letters of
Colonel Joseph Dashiell to the Governor dated the tenth
Instant, his to Colonel Richardson dated the ninth, and
Colonel Dow's letter to Colonel Dashiell dated the same
Day, It is ordered that there be two Detachments from
the twenty fourth Battalion of Militia of two Companies
each, to be commanded by a Major of that Battalion. —
That the first Detachment be composed of Capt. Postley
and Capt. Ratcliff's Companies, and the second Detachment of
Capt. Robin's and Capt. Lee's Companies, those Companies being the
most convenient to Sinnenapient-Job, that the said Detach-
ments be kept as a Guard at the said Job, the first of
them for eight Days, and then to be relieved by the second,
who shall also continue eight Days, unless as expected,
they should be sooner relieved, or the commanding Officers
should think it unnecessary to keep a Guard longer
there. —
