Town aforesaid for such Forces as may occasionally be in that Town accord-
-ing to the said act Given at Annapolis this 21 day of June 1777

Commission of Letter of Marque and Revival issued to Robert Polk
Master of the privateer Schoop called the Black John mounting Ten Cannons
Guns and two Swivels and navigated with twenty five men belonging
to William Lux, Samuel Pinckney & others of Baltimore County

Ordered, That the western shore Treasurer pay to William Neom
and Comp^y Ninety eight pounds due on acct^s passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Abraham Hall two pounds
and eleven pence amo^t of acct^s

That the said Treasurer pay to Messrs Jenifer and Hooe
two thousand pounds on account

That the said Treasurer pay to Captain George Cooke fifty
Pounds on account

Tuesday June 24th 1777
