of the Privateer Sloop called the Potowmack mounting twelve Damage Guns &  
eight Swivels Navigated with Thirty Men belonging to Robert Townsend Hood  
& others of Charles County dated the 25 Instant

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Sam Comondron  
two Thousand Dollars on Acc<sup>t</sup> of the fifth Regiment

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> July 1777

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered That the Commissary of Provisions deliver To  
Capt: King fifteen pounds Tallow & one Barrel of Tea for the plates

That the Western shore Treasurer pay to Col: Vallott  
forty two pounds ten shillings for Am<sup>t</sup> of acc<sup>t</sup> for Damage done  
his house in Kent whilst Occupied by the Soldiers

That the said Treasurer pay to John Amis Ten pounds  
fourteen shillings Am<sup>t</sup> of acc<sup>t</sup>

That the said Treasurer pay to Cornelius Garretson  
five pounds, five Shillings Am<sup>t</sup> of acc<sup>t</sup>

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen one  
hundred & fifty pounds on Acc<sup>t</sup>

Capt: (David) You will immediately proceed with the Conqueror  
to York River in Virginia, and thence up the Creek, which leads to Wmburgh  
and call upon M<sup>r</sup>s Norton & Beall for the residue of the arms Belong-  
ing to this State, which M<sup>r</sup> Norton in his favor of the 25<sup>th</sup> instant  
informs us are lodged in Williamsburgh. There is also some Gun locks  
Tm<sup>r</sup> of in the care of M<sup>r</sup>s Norton & Beall which you will also  
receive & bring together with the arms to Annapolis

of a former Agreement.
