

Commission of Sea of Marque & Reprisal issued to Josiah Dorsay Master
of the privateer sloop called the Potomack mounting twelve carriage Guns &
eight Swivels Navigated with Thirty Men belonging to Robert Townsend Hood
& others of Charles County dated the 25 Instant

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Sam^r Comondron
two Thousand Dollars on Acc^t of the fifth Regiment

Tuesday 29th July 1777

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered That the Commissary of Provisions deliver To
Capt. King fifteen pounds Tallow & one Barrel of Tar for the platoon

That the Western shore Treasurer pay to Elish Vallette
forty two pounds ten shillings for Amt of Acc^t for Damage done
his house & Rent whilst occupied by the Soldiers

That the said Treasurer pay to John Amis Ten pounds
fourteen shillings Amt of Acc^t

That the said Treasurer pay to Cornelius Ganetson
five pounds, five shillings Amt of Acc^t

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullon one
hundred & fifty pounds on Acc^t

Capt. (David) You will immediately proceed with the Conqueror
to York River in Virginia, and thence up the Creek, which leads to W^mburgh
and call upon Mess^{rs} Norton & Beall for the residue of the Arms belong-
ing to this State, which Mr Norton in his favor of the 25th instant
informs us are lodged in Williamsburgh. There is also some Gun locks
in the care of Mess^{rs} Norton & Beall which you will also
receive & bring, together with the Arms, to Annapolis

Received of Mr Robert Read thirty Musquets in consequence
of a former Agreement

That the Commissary of Stores at Annapolis deliver Sundries
for the Conqueror Galley

That the Commissary of Provisions deliver three Barrels flour
two Barrels Bread & two of Pork for the above Galley
