That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt. Walker one
hundred and fifty Pounds to be accounted for.

That the Armourer deliver to M^r: Winters eleven Gun
Bands, fifty six Gunlocks & a sufficient Quantity of Powder & Ball to
prove sixty one Bands

That Col. Henry Hollingsworth deliver to M^r: Winters
fifty Gun Bands

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Isaac Harris
one hundred & fifty seven Pounds two shillings & four pence Am^t Acc^t pass^d

That the said Treasurer pay to Tho: Snooden one hundred &
twenty six pounds seven shillings & six pence & the further Sum of seven
