James O'Hara who whilst in Captain Ramsays Comp^y of
Smallwoods Battalion, having since from Sickness, become Blind and
incapable of Service is therefore discharged

That James O'Hara Draw Stations while he continues
in Annapolis until further Directions

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Eastman & Neth
Twenty seven pounds, twelve shillings and six pence on acc^t passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Spyker three hundred
Dollars on acc^t of seventh Regiment (by Genl Smallwoods Order)

That the said Treasurer pay to General Smallwood four hundred
Dollars on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Gant of Calvert
County, two hundred and fifty pounds Cury for erecting Salt Works he having
given Bond William Jeffray Com^t Secy

That the said Treasurer pay to William Allen of same C^y
two hundred & fifty pounds Cury for the above purpose he having given
Bond Samuel Newell Secy

Commission of L^e of Marque issued to James Campbell
Capt^t of the Privateer called the Sturdy Beggar mounting fourteen Cannons
Guns & fourteen Swivels, navigated by eighteⁿ men belonging to Samuel
& Robert Purviance, Alex Bowley & others of Baltimore County

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson C^y
of Calvert County, two hundred & fifty pounds, Cury for erecting Salt Works
he having given Bond with James Lister security
