Commission of Tre of Marque issued to James Campbell
Capt: of the privateer called the Sturdy Beggar mounting fourteen Long
Guns & fourteen Swivels, navigated by eighteen Men belonging to Samuel
& Robert Purviance, Luc Bowley & others of Baltimore County

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson
of Calvert County, two hundred & fifty pounds, Curr for erecting Salt Works
he having given Bond with Francis Louisa Security
