That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Troe twenty pounds sixteen shillings eight pence due him for two months salary as Clerk to the Board of Acc<sup>t</sup>s ending this Day

That the said Treasurer pay to James Maynard four pounds ten shillings for a gun

That the said Treasurer pay to Nicholas McMarras twenty pounds Am<sup>t</sup> of acc<sup>t</sup> passed
