will not be injured, that he will enter on the said work within two weeks from
the date hereof and within six weeks from the Date hereof will deliver fifteen
dozen from Month to Month thereafter at least fifteen of the said Muskets
completely finished as aforesaid the said Deliveries to be made at Baltimore
