Ordered That Francis Fairbrother let William Neom<sup>have</sup> 500 steel

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Stephen Yoe fifteen pounds per account passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Lancelot Jacques sixty two pounds sixteen shillings for 22 fifty six 1 fourteen and one seven pound weights purchased of him for the state

That the said Treasurer pay to James Maynard six pounds seven shillings and six pence to pay for two Reams of paper

Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> October 1777

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John King six pounds eighteen shillings per account passed

Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October 1777

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Annis seven pounds per account passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Col. Samuel Hanson two hundred pounds for the use of the Marching Militia from Saint Marys and Talbot Counties to be accounted for

Commission issued to William M<sup>c</sup>Condree appointed second Lieut Capt Robert Smiths Comp<sup>y</sup> of Militia in Charles County

Saturday 18. October 1777

Present as on Yesterday Col Lloyd attended

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Joseph Ford hundred Pounds for recruiting to be charged to the first Maryland Regiment to be accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut James Fernandes one hundred and eighty Dollars to pay six Recruits for the first Maryland Regiment thirty Dollars each allowed by the act to reinforce the new army
