

Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> e November 1777

Present as on Yesterday

John Bullen Esquire is appointed Commissary of stores for the State in the room of Charles Wallace Howard who has resigned

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay Daniel Hughes two hundred and thirty nine pounds seventeen shillings and six pence amount of account passed and also the further sum of five hundred pounds on account of the prisoners under his care in Washington County

Ordered that Daniel Hughes Esq: Lieut. of Washington County may remove any of the prisoners of War under his care in Sharpshooters from that place to any other part of Washington County which he may think more convenient and proper for their residence, and that the said Daniel Hughes may also enlist a proper guard upon the Continental pay merely for the purpose of safe keeping their prisoners

Sunday 3 e November 1777

Present John E. Lloyd J. Polk J. Lee and John Rogers Esqrs

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Hym two hundred and fifty pounds agreeable to his and Abraham Green Bond to the State

That the said Treasurer pay to Richards Clappington eighteen pounds five shillings for going Express to Philadelphia

That the said Treasurer pay to James e Kay e sixty four pounds twelve shillings on account passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Tadar Burger forty six pounds fifteen shillings and three pence and the further sum of two pounds ten shillings <sup>and six pence</sup> per account passed

That the said Treasurer pay to John Fox eleven pounds due to him and twelve pounds ten shillings due to David Hampton for Wagoning per account passed

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> e November 1777

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Singleton fifteen Pounds an Express from the Governor of Virginia to Genl Washington to his orders to be charged to the State of Virginia
