seven shillings and six pence for attendance informal.

That the said Treasurer pay to Shaw and Gishorn two pounds
two shillings and eight pence per act passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw two hundred and
fifty four pounds eleven shillings and three pence due per act passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to David Evans forty six pounds
twelve shillings per account passed and the further sum of one
hundred and twenty nine pounds fifteen shillings for the use of Matthew
Cotton due him per account passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Timmons one pound
one shilling, thirteen shillings and six pence, four pounds six shillings
and three pence due per accounts passed and the further sum of four
pounds for a Musquet and Bayonet bought of him for the public
by John Shaws receipt.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut William Tudat four
hundred and fifty nine pounds fourteen shillings and six pence per act passed
so ends the proceedings of this Council Anno Regni 1777.
