Twenty Pounds at the request of the Senate & House of Delegates

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^l Richard Hanwood Sixty three
pounds seven shillings & three pence Balance of Acc^t passed

That the said Treasurer pay to John Johnson twenty two pounds
two shillings and three pence for the use of sundries, Thirty Pounds fifteen
(shillings)
