Present as on Yesterday

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Nathaniel Bond thirty eight pounds five Shillings for the purpose of Purchasing $42\frac{1}{2}$ Gallons of Whiskey for the use of the Ship Defence

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Roll who was a Private in Captam Longs Independent Company and who was taken Prisoner at Fort Washington and rescued on Paolo, thirty one Pounds, five Shillings due him for Wages and Subsistence per account passed the Board of Accounts

Ordered That the Officer commanding onboard the Ship Defence deliver James Calhoun Esquire four two pounds with a proportion of fixed Ammunition hereof three three Pounds the property of said James Calhoun now onboard of the Ship Independence and a Quantity of Ammunition therefor.

Friday 12 December 1777

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Maxwell fifty eight Pounds Twelve Shillings and two pence for the use of William Dordley and twenty one Pounds eleven Shillings and six pence for the use of Isaac Spencer due to them per account passed the Board of Accounts

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Gordon seventy two Pounds on account of the Third Regiment

That the said Treasurer pay to Azel Warfield seventy eight Pounds as per account passed the Board.

That the said Treasurer pay to Logan & Minskie twelve Pounds due per account passed the Board

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to John Johnson thirteen yards sheeting Linnen on account

Saturday 13th December 1777

Ordered That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas Gordon three hundred and eight Pounds, seventeen Shillings & ten pence for the pay of his Company marching Militia per Pay roll passed by the Board of Accounts
