That the said Treasurer pay to William Howard eleven Pounds
Thirteen shillings and one penny half penny am^t of account past due.

The Comitie proceeded to the choice of a member in the room of
William Denole Esquire who refused and James Hindman Esquire
was unanimously elected.

at the next County Court.

County and William Morris for Worcester County.

Joseph Nicholson, William Geddes, and Donaldson Gates of
Kent County or any two of them are hereby appointed to audit settle
and adjust the accounts of the militia of the Eastern Shore who
have been in actual service since the Invasion of this State
and any accounts that may have arisen against the State in
consequence of said Invasion according to a Resolution of the
General Assembly.
