That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Clement Hamfor one hundred and forty four pounds, fourteen shillings and eight pence Bal<sup>c</sup> of account passed —

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> January 1778

Present as on Yesterday, James Brue Esq: - appeared —

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt: Montjoy Bailey nine hundred and forty one pounds six shillings and two pence to be lodged with John Hanson & be by him delivered over to Col: John Stull for the use of the marching Militia of Washington only due to them per accounts passed the Board of Accounts —

That the said Treasurer pay to Jacob Hover seven hundred and fifty pounds to be delivered over to Daniel Hughes Esq: for defraying Expences of Prisoners in Washington of which account to be rendered —

That the said Treasurer pay to Jacob Hover two hundred pounds to be delivered into Col: John Stull for defraying Expences of Prisoners in Washington County of which account to be rendered —

That the said Treasurer pay to Major John Stewart one thousand five hundred dollars for the recruiting Service to be charged to the second Regiment

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Merkin one hundred and twenty dollars in the recruiting Service and to be accounted for —

That the said Treasurer pay to Captain Benah Maybury one hundred and fifty five pounds nineteen shillings and one penny Bal of account passed the same and also the further sum of one hundred pounds on account —

That the said Treasurer pay to James Maynard ten pounds for expenses as per account passed the Board —

That the said Treasurer pay to Cornelius Mills three hundred Dollars to be funded in the recruiting Service —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt: Bennett Matthews four hundred & forty nine pounds one shilling & six pence for on acc<sup>t</sup> of the Galley Independence
