

Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> February 1778.

Present as on Yesterday —

Ordered That W<sup>r</sup> Lyall deliver to Mr Baker 12 Bushels  
of salt for the use of this State —

That the armourer put up onboard of Mr John Gibsons Boat  
150 stand of arms last imported to be delivered to Col<sup>r</sup> Burkhead Lieut  
of Talbot County for the use of that County —

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Francis Baker two  
hundred and fifty pounds eighteen shillings and five pence amount of account  
paid by the Board for the Purchase of Pork &c and also the further sum  
of one hundred and fifty pounds on account to be expended in the purchase of  
Pork —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas B. Hodgkin one hundred  
and eighty four pounds fifteen shillings and six pence half penny for his  
Salary as per account paid by the Board of Accounts —

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Fox twenty eight pounds eleven  
shillings and four pence half penny for his Salary as per account paid

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Wheel five hundred pounds  
to be delivered over to Col<sup>r</sup> Nathaniel Potter on account to be expended in pur-  
chasing Pork for the use of this State —

That Thirty Bushels of Salt be sent in Bags in Gibsons Boat  
for W<sup>r</sup> Potter to use Pork for the Public —

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Col<sup>r</sup> Stone four  
Pair of Shoes to be charged to the first Regiment

That the said Commissary deliver to Daniel Munro one hundred  
he paying for the same —

That the said Commissary deliver to Maj Stewart two Blankets  
for the Recruits of the 2<sup>d</sup> Regiment

That the Quarter Master provide a Barrack for the Recruits of  
g<sup>r</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> Reg<sup>r</sup> and also to supply said Barrack with wood —
