Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Benjamin Brooke three thousand Dollars out of the money remitted by Congress for the purchase of Provisions to be delivered over and charged to the Capt. Robert Owen Purchaser in Prince Georges County.

Capt. Robert Owen is appointed Agent for Purchasing Provisions in Montgomery County in the room of William Waters refused to Act.

Col. John Hoffman Stone appointed Auditor General by the General Assembly. Qualified in presence of the Governor and Council by taking the several Oaths directed in the Resolution, and subscribing a Declaration of his Belief in the Christian Religion and giving Bond with Thomas Stone Esquire Security for the faithful Performance of his Duty as Auditor General.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Samuel Griffith two thousand Dollars out of the money remitted by Congress for the purchase of Provisions to be delivered over and charged to Capt. Robert Owen Purchaser of Provisions in Montgomery County.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Samuel Griffith three hundred Dollars out of the money remitted by Congress for the Recruiting Service to be charged to the third Maryland Regiment.

That the said Treasurer pay to Elisha Winters three hundred and thirty one Pounds seventeen Shillings and six pence due per Account pass by Act.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jesse Busey five Pounds for a year.

That the said Treasurer pay to James Calhoun Esq. two thousand five hundred and twenty six Pounds fourteen Shillings and nine pence out of the thirty thousand Dollars appropriated by the Assembly due to him per account passed by the Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. Henry Schneckely one hundred and sixty eight Pounds eight Shillings for the use of John Full per account passed by the Auditor General.

William Spicer of Ann Arundel County took the Oath of Fidelity to his State and Richard Thomas of Montgomery County took the Affirmation according to the late Act and Certificate given.
