Ordered That the western Shore Treasurer pay to W^o. Richard Dallam
one hundred and six Pounds, seven Shillings due on the Purchase of Cloathing part
of the Account examined and passed by the Committee of Claims -

That the said Treasurer pay to Christopher Edlin one hundred and thirty two
Pounds, thirteen Shillings for the use and to be delivered over to several Persons due on
Certificates allowed by the Committee of Claims

That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Dallam Esq^r one hundred &
forty eight Pounds, seventeen Shillings and seven Pence to be paid over by him to
several Persons and the further sum of forty eight Pounds on his own proper
Account as per Accounts passed by the Committee of Claims

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Alexander Truman one hundred
Pounds to be delivered over to George Keports and charged to him in Account
to be expended in the making of Soldier's Cloathing -

That the said Treasurer pay to Zephaniah Turner five Pounds for
the use of Ezekiah Gardner due to him on Account passed by the Com^o of Claims

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Egerly sixty Dollars (Dorothy
he having enlisted James a Miller, on Account for the recruiting Service) -

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Senise Esq^r nine
thousand Dollars out of the Money remitted by Congress for the purchase of Provs^s

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Benjamin
Brooks of the third Regiment Red Cloth sufficient for a coat and any other
for a Waistcoat, one piece Brittaines and one Blanket & Trimmings for the above

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Alex Truman
two pair shoes, Red Cloth sufficient for a coat and as much of any other kind
as will make a Waistcoat and Breeches with Trimmings to be charged to the 6th Reg^t
