Whereas the Board on the 13th Day of December last drew
an order on the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore payable to William Wheatley Esq^r
for one hundred and four Pounds, fifteen Shillings and eight Pence due to him
by accounts passed by the Board of Accounts - and also an order on same
Treasurer payable to William Raflet for three hundred and sixty three Pounds,
three Shillings and two Pence due to his Company whilst in actual service per
accounts passed by the Board, but the said orders are now returned unpaid
by the said Treasurer. Wherefore it is ordered that the Western Shore Treasurer
pay to the said William Wheatley the said sum of one hundred and four
Pounds, fifteen Shillings and eight Pence and the further sum of three
hundred and sixty three Pounds, three Shillings and two Pence to be
delivered to William Raflet due to his Company as aforesaid.

in Queen Anne's County, out of the Money remitted by Congress for the Purchase
of Provisions to be accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Howard twenty one Pounds
seven Shillings and six Pence to be delivered over to John Thomas and the
further sum of one hundred and sixty eight Pounds to be delivered over to John
Ellick due to them per accounts passed by the Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Ed. Thomas Dorsey Purchase
of Provisions in Ann Arundel County three thousand Dollars out of the
money remitted by Congress for the Purchase of Provisions to be accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Anno sixty Dollars
Bondy due to William Jennings enlisted by him and the further sum of sixteen
Dollars due to him for enlisting the said William Jennings passed by D. Bruce.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Thomas One thousand
four hundred Dollars out of the money remitted by Congress for the Purchase of Provisions
