hundred and twenty Muskets & Bayonets, 250 Cartridge Boxes and five thousand
Pins.

Mr. Williams from the House of Delegates delivered to the Governor
the following Resolved

By the House of Delegates April 9th 1770.

Moved That the Governor and the Council be empowered and requested
during the Session of Assembly to appoint and commission Militia Officers for
Cecil, Harford, and (granted) Kent or any other County where it may be judged necessary
by G. Duvall. E. H. D. This endorsed, By the Senate April 9th
1770 and assented to By order R. Ridgely S. Gen.

Certificate given to Col. Birchhead that it appears necessary that he shall
draw on the Eastern Shore Treasurer for four Pounds, fourteen Shillings and six
Pence as per Account of William Maynard and for Six pounds, five Shillings as
a Certificate of John Bravo Register of the Orphans Court on Account of William
Bimfield a wounded Soldier in the first Clap of the 4th Batt of Talbot County.
