Resolved That the Governor and the Council be empowered and requested
during this Session of Assembly to appoint and commission Militia Officers for
Calvert, St. Marys, and (groins) Counties or any other County where it may be judged necessary
By order G. Duwall. C. H. D. Thus endorsed, By the Senate April 9th
1778 read and assented to By order R. Ridgely S. Sen.
