

Commission issued to Aquila Hall, Aquila Pace, John Love, Alexander Cowan &
John Ramsay appointed Justices of the Orphan Court for Harford County.

Whereas by a Deposition lodged in Council that John Schwei and
John Gomwell both of Anne Arundel County, have deuaded and advised a certain Elijah
Robinson Esq. from taking the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State accord-
ing to the act of Assembly in such case made and Provided which conduct of the said
John Schwei and John Gomwell appear to this Board to be inimical to the cause of
America and is a good ground to believe their going at large may be dangerous to
the Safety of this State. Wherefore it is Ordered that the Sheriff of Anne Arundel
County take the aforesaid John Schwei and John Gomwell, if in his County and
their Bodies have before the Governor and Council at Annapolis immediately to
Answer the Premises and further that the said Sheriff summon the aforesaid Elijah
Robinson Esq. to appear before the Governor and Council immediately at
Annapolis to testify the truth of his Knowledge concerning the Premises.

Zephaniah Turner Esq. of Charles County appointed Auditor General
by the Assembly in the room of Col. Stone who has resigned, qualified in Presence
of the Governor and Council by taking the several Oaths directed in the Resolves and giving Bond
with Thomas Semmes & Alex McPherson Security for the faithful Performance
of his Duty.

thirteen Shillings and four Pence per Amount passed by the Act^r

That the said Treasure pay to Mary Priestly fifty four Pounds eight
Shillings
