John Schuier and John Cromwell appear to this Board to be inimical to the Cause of  
America and is a good Ground to believe their going at large may be dangerous to  
the Safety of this State. Wherefore it is Ordered that the Sheriff of Ann Arundel  
County take the aforesaid John Schuier and John Cromwell, if in his County and  
their Bodies have before the Governor and Council at Annapolis immediately to  
answer the Premises and further that the said Sheriff summon the aforesaid Elyah  
Robinson Esq. to appear before the Governor and Council immediately at  
Annapolis to testify the truth of his Knowledge concerning the Premises.

Zephaniah Turner Esq. of Charles County appointed Auditor General  
by the Assembly in the room of Col. Stone who has resigned, Qualified in Presence  
of the Governor and Council by taking the usual Oath directed in the Resolve and giving Bond
