You are to proceed to Cambridge with the Baltimore Galley and there deliver the Arms you have in under the care of such Person as Robert Goldborough Esquire shall direct you, who is requested to write to the Suints of Dorchester and (Carolme) Counties the five Boxes marked D are for Dorset and the five marked C for Carolme 150 Stand for each County. You are to receive at Cambridge what Continental and State Goods are there and with them return to Annapolis with all Dispatch none of the Goods must be taken on board loose and if any of the Packages want repair it must be done by those who have the care of the Goods take every precaution to prevent embezzlement.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^l William Hyde two hundred & thirty two Pounds and seven Pence half Penny to be by him delivered over to Capt. Robert Conway due him per Act. passed by the A General

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen three hundred & sixty Pounds and two pence per Account passed by the Board of Accounts

That the said Treasurer pay to Walter Bowie six pounds, fifteen Shillings & six pence for the use of Geo. Allen per Act. passed by the A Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Todd seven Pounds, seven Shillings per Account passed
