Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to Aquila Parker forty eight Pounds for being Adjutant to the Gun Powder Batt and the further Sum of five Pounds for D^o to the 8th Batt of Militia per Aut^o passed by the A General

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Beriah Maybury Fifty Pounds on Acc^o

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Bennett & Matthews five hundred and thirty seven Pounds, fourteen shillings and eight Pence due himself and others of the Galley Independance as per Aut^o passed by the A Gen^l —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Stewenson seven Pounds and nine Pence for the use of Henry Boorman per Aut^o passed by the A Gen^l

That M. Cryvall deliver to Joseph Ashmead Continental Commissary all the Park in his Possession belonging to the Continent and as much Salt as he may want for the same keeping a just Account of it —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to M. Chevier Sundry Cloathing for the Seamen of the Chester Galley per List sent charging them accordingly —

Commission of a Letter of Marque and Reprisal issued to Daniel Deshon Master of the Sloop Molly mounting ten Carriage Guns navigated by thirty men belonging to the State of Maryland —

Commission issued to Samuel Hanson, Daniel Semser, George Dent and Robert Young appointed Justices of the Crispham Court for Charles County.
