Ordered that M. Cryvall deliver to Capt. Rogers 3 Bunches of Pork 4 Bunches of Beef 100 lb. Ship's bread one Bunch flour 50 fathom 2 Inch rope and 20 Gallons of Whiskey for the use of the General Smallwood and to Capt Matthew one Bunch Whiskey for the Galley Independence

That M. Cryvall deliver to Lieut Boyle one Bunch Whiskey, 3 Bunches flour four Bunches Beef two Bunches Pork and 8 Bunches Bread & 150 lb of Bacon for the Baltimore Galley

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Skirt of Capt Brownes Company of Artillery one Blanket and Russia Drab suff. for 2 pair Breaches

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Baitling 2 pair Shoes and 4 pair Stockings for two Recruits charged to Genl. Pulaskis Legion

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Boyle two Bolts Canvas for the Galley. Baltimore

That the western shore Treasurer pay to David Schwin Fifteen pounds for the use of Nicholas Frangor per cert. allowed by the Aud Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Nicholas Manger one thousand six hundred and eighty Dollars to enable him to pay the fifty Dollars Bounty to each of the following substitutes enlisted to serve for three years or during the War from Saint Marys County viz: Pat. Kelly, William McGe, Charles McGe, John Rock, John Holmes, Austin Howard, Bennet Chestnut, Thomas Green Alvey, Justinian Pullock, John Blundell, Elias Henry, John Baptist Bailey, Richard Hall, Travers Alvey, Joseph Shanks Zephaniah Williams James Thomas, Henry Harley, George Collins, William Holt Edward Harley John Farden Jeremiah Scabler Thomas Curtis John Sprague Athan.
