That the western shore Treasurer pay to Samuel Hanson Esq. fifty eight Pounds, seventeen shillings & seven Pence of A/c passed by the Alg.

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Williamson one hundred and seventy six pounds, thirteen shillings & eight Pence to be delivered over to Capt Thomas Ireland due his Compy of Militia whilst in actual Service per pay roll examined & passed by the Alg.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Burgess nineteen Pounds two shillings & eleven Pence due to him & part of his Company whilst in actual Service per A/c. passed by the Aid General.

That the said Treasurer Pay to James Phillips forty four pounds nine shillings for the use of Henry Strong for Waggon hire fifty nine pounds, five shillings & six Pence for the use of Tho. Smith and Thirty seven pounds seventeen shillings for the use of Capt. Glenn (his Compy) of A/c passed by the A General.
