Thursday 21 May 1770.

Present as on yesterday—

The Dolphin & Plater are to proceed immediately to Baltimore  
there receive of Capt. Keports, the Arms Accoutements &c. ordered from there and  
with them to proceed to the Head of Elk and there deliver to Col. Henry Hollingsworth  
what they may have received at Baltimore. The two fido pieces &c. put in the  
Plater here must be delivered to Major Smith at Balt. as soon as the Arms  
&c. are delivered these vessels are to return to Annapolis as speedily as possible.

Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay Lieut. Semmes fifty  
Dollar the Bounty due to James Garden for the first Regiment

That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Eaton two pounds thirteen  
shillings and nine pence expence in taking up a Defenter as per Act passed by A<sup>g</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col. Thomas Dorsey some pounds  
for the use of John McDaniel per Account passed by the A<sup>g</sup> and the  
further Sum of eighty four Pounds, twelve shillings and one penny due  
him per Act. passed by the A<sup>g</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Downes fifty Pounds one  
shilling to be delivered over to Pat. O'Bryan due him for Waggonia &c. per  
Accounts passed by the Board of A<sup>g</sup> appointed to audit & settle the A<sup>g</sup>  
of the Mil<sup>t</sup>. of the E Shore in consequence of the Invasion 1777
