Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Abraham Faw two Pounds four shillings and six pence for the use of Leonard Lortz, two Pounds four shillings and six pence for the use of Adam Boyer and two Pounds thirteen shillings and five pence for the use of Peter & Mimm as if Auct. passed by the Auditor General

That the said Treasurer pay to William Hindman six Pounds for the use of William Raso per Auct. passed by the Aud Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Gilbert Falconer four Pounds eighteen shillings and six pence for the use of Evan Jones per Auct. passed by the Auct. and the further Sum of one hundred and fifty five Pounds twelve shillings & eight pence due him & his Company whilst in service of pay roll earned & passed Auct.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Allen Thomas one hundred and twenty six Pounds eighteen shillings & six pence and twenty Pounds eight shillings and three pence for the use of Richard Bond forty Pounds nine shillings and nine pence for the use of Capt. James Roach & his Company and three Pounds eight shillings for the use of Samuel Abell as per Accounts passed by the Aud. Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Allen Thomas fifty Pounds twelve shillings and four pence per Auct. passed by the Aud Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Abraham Faw two thousand Pounds, on Account of the Banacks to be accounted for

That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to Col. James Murray four hundred and twenty nine Pounds, eighteen shillings for the use of Capt. Lewis Handley due to him & his Company as per Auct. passed by the Aud Genl.

Ordered That Mr. Lysall deliver to Rich^d. Munnow for David Jenifer Purchaser of Prov. in Charles County three Bushels of Salt
