That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut. Clark of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Regiment, Cloth for a suit of Cloath.

William Steven son a Native of this State who hath long resided in Great Britain and is now lately that is to say within three months last past returned into this State appeared before the Governor and Council and before them did take repeat and Subscribe the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State contained in the Act entitled an Act to Punish certain Crimes and a Kidnapping and to prevent the growth of Popery.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer Pay to Samuel Hughes Esq. two hundred and seventy pounds seven shillings and nine Pence due for repairing Fort Frederick per Ac't passed by the Adm Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Stewart one thousand and forty six pounds, seven shillings and five Pence and also the further sum of one hundred & fifty eight pounds, seventeen shillings for the use of Lux and Bowley per Ac't passed by the Adm General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Stade seventeen pounds per Ac't passed by the Adm General

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Benjamin Brookes fifty Pounds and the further sum of fifteen Pounds due him per Ac't passed by the Adm Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Sprigg Eighty six Pounds for the use of Isaac Cooper & the further sum of two Pounds one shilling and eight pence for the use of Mark Boatby per Ac't passed by the Adm Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Comt. Acheson seven pounds per Ac't passed by the Adm Genl.
