William Stevenson a Native of this State who hath long resided in Great Britain and is now lately that is to say within three Months last past returned into this State appeared before the Governor and Council and before them did take repeat and Subscribe the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State contained in the Act entitled an Act to Punish certain Crimes and Misdemeanors and to prevent the Growth of Toryism

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Samuel Hughes Esq^r five hundred and seventy pounds seven shillings and nine Pence due for repairing Fort Frederick per Act^s passed by the Aud Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Stewart one thousand and forty six pounds, seven shillings and six Pence and also the further Sum of one hundred & sixty eight pounds, seventeen shillings for the use of Lux and Bowley per Act^s passed by the Aud General

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Stade seventeen pounds per Act^s passed by the Aud General

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Benjamin Brookes fifty pounds and the further Sum of fifteen pounds due him per Act^s passed by the Aud Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Sprigg Eighty six pounds for the use of Isaac Cooper & the further Sum of two pounds one shilling and eight Pence for the use of Mark Beatty per Act^s passed by the Aud Gen^l.
