

On Examination of Thomas Leon, who appears by his own confession to have been an Ensign in the fifth Regiment of the British Troops and to have lately come out of Philadelphia, having as he says resigned his Commission in the Month of June 1777. This Board not being satisfied that he is not now in the British Service and on some evil Design travelling about this State and being of Opinion that the Truth of his Case may be better enquired into in the Neighbourhood of Philadelphia, especially of General Irvine, Col. Mearns of Maryland or a Major Giles to whom he refers for a Knowledge of his Situation in Philadelphia should be released. It is ordered that the said Thomas Leon be kept under Guard til some of the Recruits are sent from hence and that he be sent in Charge of the Officer who may go with the Recruits to the Camp where he is to be delivered to the proper Officer with this Commitment in Order that due Inquiry may be made.

That the said Treasurer pay Daniel Bryan ninety one Pounds and six Pounds six shillings & three pence Amt. of Act. passed by the Principal G. to the Aud Genl.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Sol Higginbottom of the 7th Regt Independence 7 yd Linen and one pair Shoes.
