That Mr Lysall furnish Capt Mafey with 15 Gallons Whiskey for the Boat Amelia —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Richard Sappington Surgeon Assistant to the 3<sup>d</sup> Regt Sagotby for a boat Amen for two pair Breeches two waistcoats two Shirts and one pair Shoes

Commissions of a Letter of Marque & Reprisal issued Jonathan Parson master of the Sloop called the Fly mounting two Swivel Guns navigated by six Men, belonging to Samuel & Robert Purviance and others of Baltimore also to Henry Yeatts master of the Schooner called the Savage mounting four Savage Guns & four Swivels navigated by twelve men belonging to Sam<sup>l</sup> Robert Purviance and others of Baltimore
