

It being represented to this Board by James Calhoun Esq. Deputy Quarter Master General for the western shore of this State that a Number of Waggon are now wanted to carry Flour belonging to the Government to convenient Landings from several Mills in Baltimore and Harford Counties, where the same have been manufactured for the use of the Army. It is requested that the Magistrates of those Counties respectively, will on the Application of the said James Calhoun or other Person or Persons acting under him, issue Warrants for the impressing Waggon necessary for carrying the said Flour to convenient Landings, directing the Warrants to the Constables of the Hundreds and requiring them to impress the Number of Waggon and Teams mentioned in the Warrants respectively so that the Burthen may be divided as nearly equal as may be

That the said Treasurer Pay to James Bond four thousand Dollars to be delivered over to William Bond son of Joshua purchaser of Provisions in Harford County on Account

Whereas on or about the twenty sixth day of March last it was adjudged by this Board that there were good grounds to believe that the going at Large of Edward Tilghman Esq. of Queen Annes County might be dangerous to the Safety of this State and this Board did therefore order that he should give Bond payable to this State in the Penalty of five thousand Pounds Current Money with sufficient Security to be approved of by this Board or by some Justice of the Peace for Queen Annes County conditioned for his the said Edward Tilghman's personal Appearance before the then next general Court to be held for the Eastern shore to answer for his going into Philadelphia whilst in Possession of the Enemy without having Permission from the Governor and Council of this State and not departing the said Court without leave thereof and further for his not going out of Queen Annes County
